

DRIVING FROM WHISTLER

1. Follow Hwy 99 (Sea-to-Sky Highway) north toward Pemberton. Continue straight through Pemberton following the signs towards Mount Currie and Lillooet. Note: check your fuel as the last gas station enroute to Tsek Hot Springs is the Lil'wat gas station in Mount Currie.
2. Turn right at the BC Highway directional sign (green with white lettering) to Lillooet, at the church in the village of Mount Currie. Note: If you need to re-fuel, continue straight through this intersection to Lil'wat gas station approximately 500m down Pemberton Portage Rd.
3. As you travel through Lil'wat land, you're still on Hwy 99. Continue driving through this flat, agricultural land.
4. Turn right onto In-SHUCK-ch Forest Service Road. The road sign is brown with yellow lettering.
5. As you travel the In-SHUCK-ch Forest Service Road you are travelling on the east side of Lillooet Lake. There are signs in bright yellow indicating what kilometer you have reached along the road.

Keep left at the fork past the 28 km marker so you continue along the In-SHUCK-ch Forest Service Road.
6. You are nearing Tsek Hot Springs when you see the 44 km marker on the road. There will be a sign (green with white lettering) saying: Skookumchuck (Tsek) Hot Springs.

Turn right 500 metres after seeing the green and white sign.
7. Follow the gravel road till you reach the gatehouse and the entrance to Tsek Hot Springs and campground.
